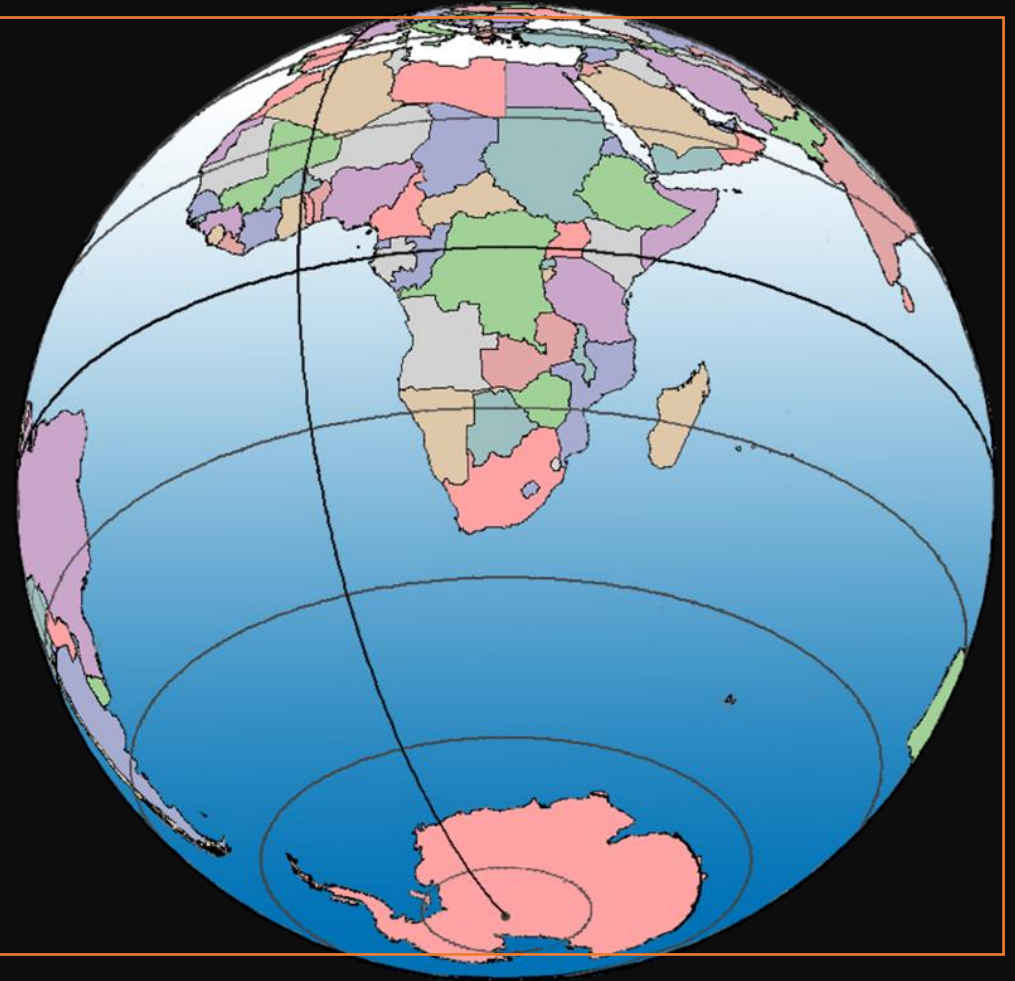

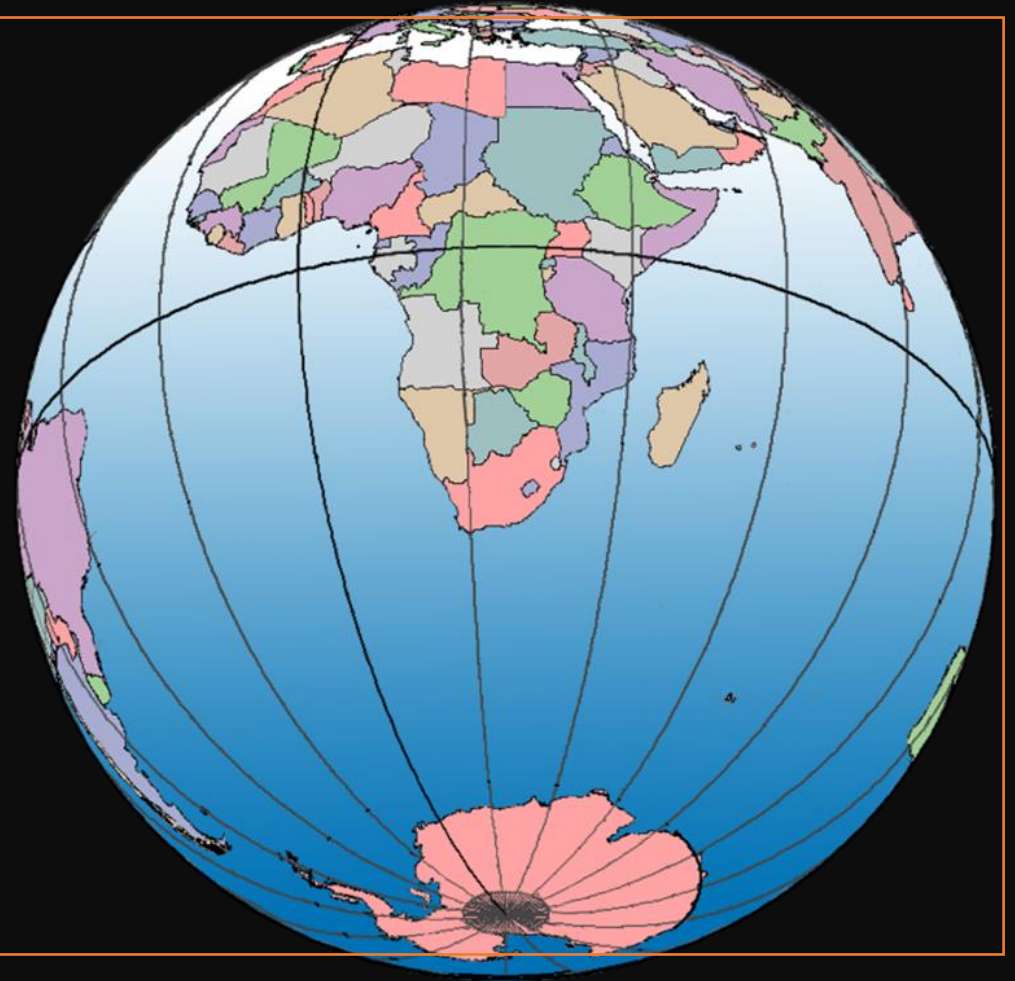
# Lines of latitude and longitude

- Parallel: lines that are always the same distance from one another

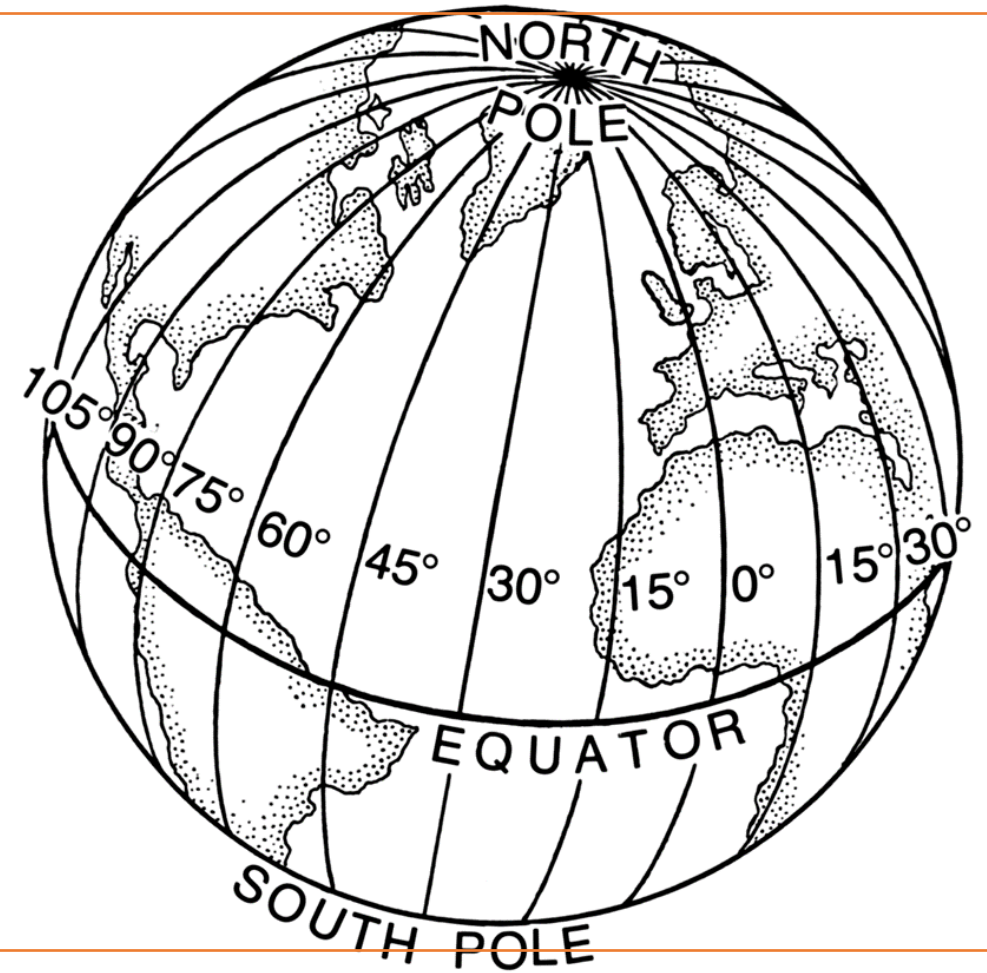


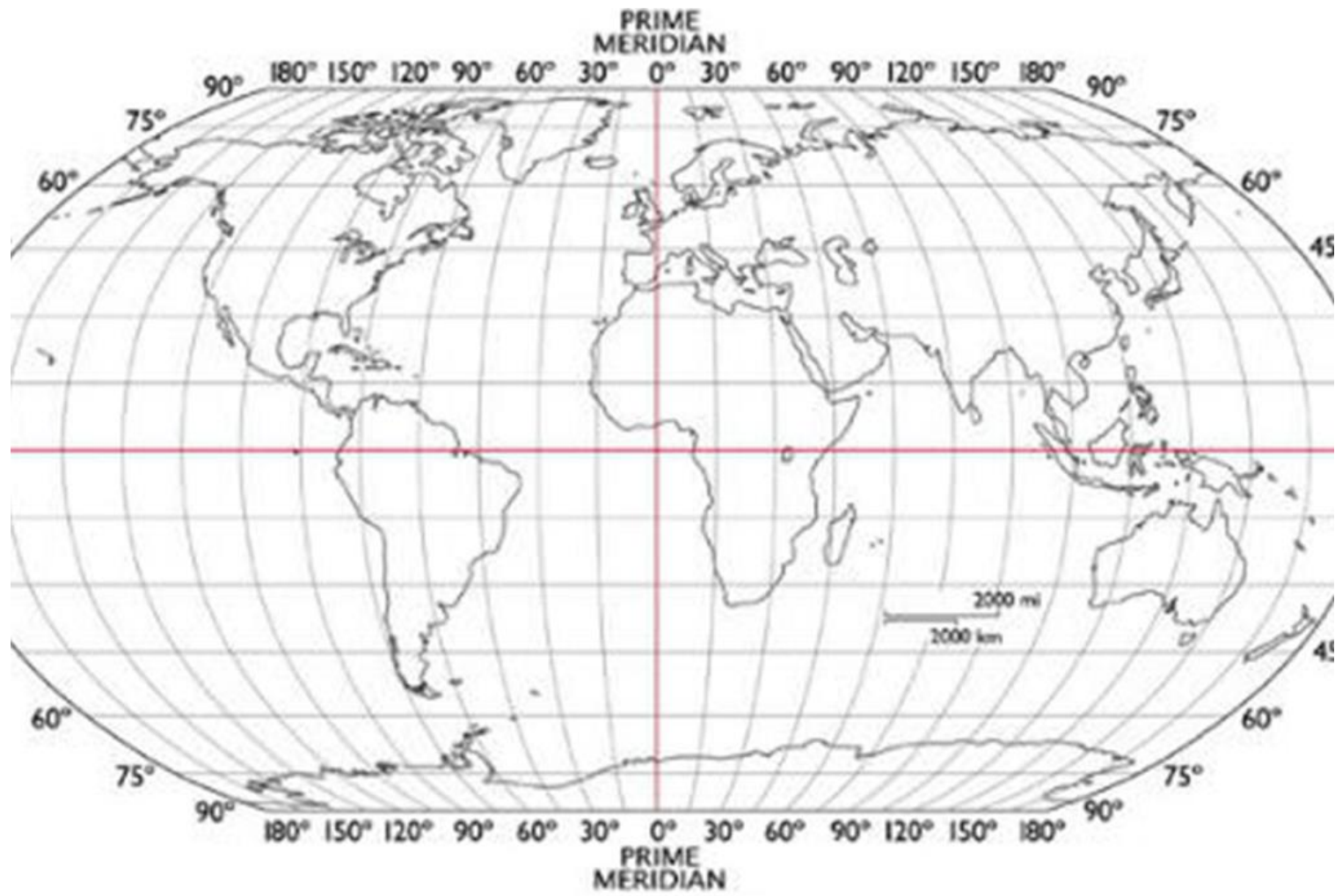
- Longitude
